

**CEP SUMMER SCHOOL  
STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT**

**Any student enrolled in Community Extension Programs High School Summer School program who commits any of the following acts or actions will be subject to expulsion without a refund.**

Substantially disrupts any school activity or knowingly and intentionally promotes, encourages, or causes others to substantially disrupt any school activity.

Directly or indirectly damages or defaces, or attempts to damage or deface, any school property at any time, or another person's property on school premises or during a school activity.

Intentionally, knowingly or recklessly, causes any physical injury to any school employee, student, volunteer, or visitor; intentionally places any school employee, student, volunteer or visitor in reasonable apprehension of imminent physical injury; or knowingly touches any school employee, student, volunteer, or visitor with the intent to injure, insult, or provoke such person.

Possesses, handles, transmits, or conceals, while on school premises or at any school activity, any object that can be deemed dangerous; including, but not limited to, guns, knives, explosive devices, propelled objects, thrown objects, gas, acid, clubs, tools, or related objects.

Directly or indirectly commits, or attempts to commit, theft of any school property or another person's property, on school premises or during a school activity.

Uses, possess, or is under the influence of any form of tobacco, alcoholic beverage, drug, narcotic, marijuana, or any related substance, or paraphernalia for any of the foregoing while on school premises or during a school activity. This does not apply to lawfully prescribed drugs or medications which are used or possessed in the manner prescribed, provided, however, that the use or possession of any such drug or medication shall be disclosed to school administration at the time it is brought on school premises and shall be deposited in the office if required by the school administrators.

Shows disrespect to any school employee, visitor, or volunteer by using obscenities, profanity, profane, or obscene gestures or any other acts of defiance which disrupts school procedures, order, or discipline.

Uses obscene or profane language or gestures to or with another student or students on school premises.

Recklessly operates any motor vehicle, bicycle, or other mode of transportation on school premises.

Forges, modifies, or falsifies any attendance notes, notes from home, doctors, teachers, etc.

Knowingly, intentionally, or recklessly contributes to libelous to slanderous statements or remarks concerning a school employee, student, volunteer, or visitor, either orally or by use of the written word. Intentionally or knowingly uses any school equipment in the production or reproduction of unauthorized publications or data entry into computers or word processors, which could prove harmful and disruptive to school procedures, order, or discipline.

Violates any provision of a code of conduct of Community Extension Programs.

### Examples of Misconduct

1. Cheating
2. Obscene Language
3. Fighting
4. Insubordination
5. Disturbing a class or extra-curricular activity
6. Forging attendance notes
7. Throwing or propelling objects
8. Tardiness
9. Attempting to damage lockers
10. Truancy
11. Ditching
12. Loitering in restrooms, hallways, or parking lots
13. Leaving campus during the regular school day without checking out with the attendance office
14. Obscene language on clothing
15. Smoking or possessing any form of tobacco, drugs, or alcohol

### Warning

Criminal trespassing in the State of Arizona is a Class 3 Misdemeanor – ARS 13-1502

Other local violations may include:

- a. Interference with peaceful conduct of an educational institution  
Class 1 Misdemeanor – ARS 12-2911
- b. Disorderly Conduct – Class 1 Misdemeanor – ARS 13-2904
- c. Loitering – Class 1 Misdemeanor – ARS 13-2905
- d. A person who knowingly insults or abuses a teacher on school grounds or while in the performance of his/her duties is guilty of a Class 3 Misdemeanor. ARS – 15-507A
